The camera trap surveys form an essential part of the research and education projects by the Landmark Foundation's Leopard and Predator Project. Camera traps let us identify individual leopards occupying an area leading to a better understanding of: population densities, what prey is available, the leopards activity patterns, and it helps us convey a message to those interested in wildlife in their areas and the greater conservation project.

We use the Bushnell Trophy Cams because they offer excellent quality of the images and video, and the battery life is the best available.

In South Africa these cameras cost R2800 including SD card. **If you would like to sponsor a camera** to the project we will send you highlights and results captured from the camera every four months for the period of one year. **Our goal is to obtain 75 cameras** to undertake the research project effectively. Your contribution would help us to better understand these elusive animals and contribute toward their conservation.
